Article 1 – Legal provisions

Article 2 – Access to the website

Article 3 – Content of the website

Article 4 - The management of the website

Article 6 – Data collection

Your data is collected by TGA and (an) external processor(s). Personal data means: all information about an identified or identifiable natural person; "identifiable" meaning a natural person who can be identified directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, identification number, location data, an online identifier, or one or more elements characteristic of the physical, physiological, genetic, psychological, economic, cultural, or social identity.

The personal data that is collected on the website is mainly used by the administrator for maintaining relationships with you and, if applicable, for processing your orders. They are registered in a customer register and the customer register, obtained in this way, is reported to the Dutch Data Protection Authority. The notification number Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens (Data protection authority) is: 1A257.

Article 7 – Your rights with regard to your data

Pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 2, sub b, of the General Data Protection Regulation, everyone has the right to inspect and rectify or erase their personal data or limit their processing, as well as the right to object to the processing and the right to data transferability. Every request to this end must be accompanied by a copy of a valid proof of identity, which you have signed and on which you have stated the address where you can be contacted. You will receive a reply to your request within 1 month of the submitted request. Dependent on the complexity of the requests and the number of requests, this period can be extended by 2 months, if necessary.

Article 8 – Processing of personal data

In the event of any violation of any laws or regulations that the visitor is suspected of and for which the authorities need personal information that the administrator has collected, these will be provided to them after an explicit and reasoned request from those authorities, after which these personal details will no longer be available. In such an instance, the personal data will no longer fall under the protection of the provisions of this privacy statement.
